- ✓ A ScienceQuest session might include a field trip to a museum, a discussion with an expert on their chosen subject, a search for science in their own neighborhoods, online research, or hands-on activities or experiments.
- ✓ After several weeks of exploring their question, the team builds and publishes their own website describing their project!
